The Rev. Rod McClarnon, originally from Indiana, served 24 years as a United Methodist Pastor in The Florida Annual Conference. Prior to being called into ministry, he owned a financial consulting firm in Florida for 7 years. He attended Candler School of Theology at Emory University and graduated in June of 1982. He received his BA and an MBA from the Inter-American University of Puerto Rico while stationed with the United States Air Force from 1966-1970. He is married with two grown children and two beautiful granddaughters. He has served as President of the Florida Annual Conference Board of Pensions and Health Benefits and was a board member for four years on the Conference Board of Finance and Administration. He is also past President of the Southeastern Jurisdictional United Methodist Association of Church Business Administrators.

Bill Mauldin worked as an attorney before serving for 18 years as a United Methodist minister in North Georgia and North Mississippi. After moving to North Carolina, he spent three and a half years on the staff of Mountain Mediation Services, a local non-profit community mediation center that operates in the seven-county area west of Asheville. While there he served as executive director and as community outreach director. In July of 2006, Bill began his own practice focusing on civil trial court mediation, conflict transformation training, and group facilitation for churches and other organizations.
